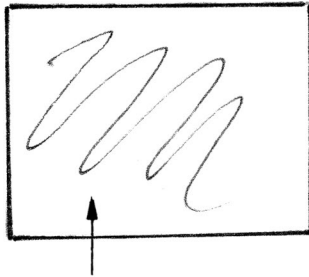


Beak Book (or Hidden Book)

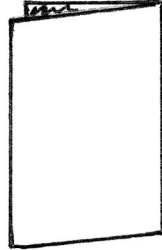
Use paper that is quite thin.
 Rectangular paper is best to start with.
 Practice with scrap paper

 valley fold

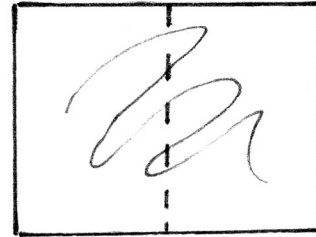
 mountain fold



Fold in half shortways

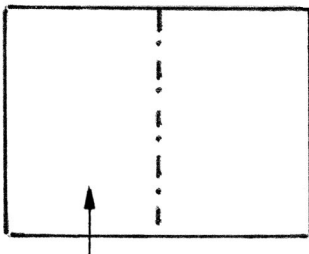


Open out

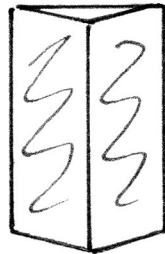


Turn the paper over

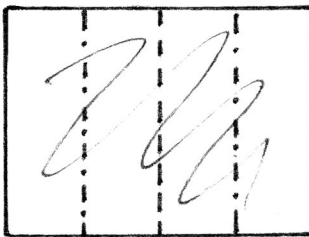
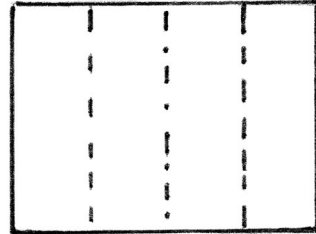
patterned side (although both or neither side can have pattern or image or text)



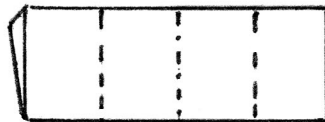
plain side



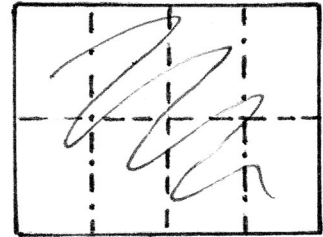
Fold each edge to the centre to make an accordion or zigzag fold



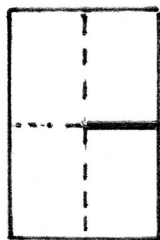
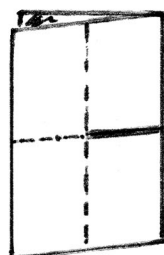
Turn over



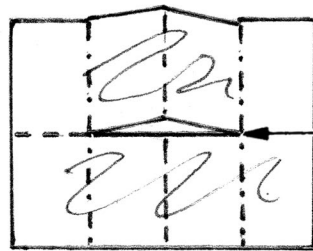
Fold in half longways & open out.

8 panels on each side

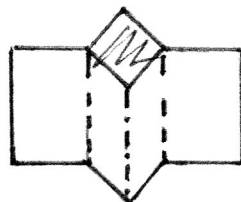
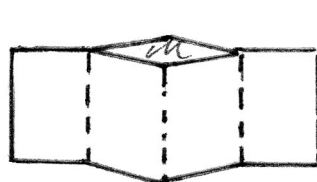


cut



(beak!)

Draw along one crease, from the **folded** edge, then cut along that line for one panel plus a little bit further (about 2mm or 1/16 inch). Fold back in half lengthways, then push edges together to form a cross.



Bring the back arm of the cross round to the front. Collapse pages and fold them into a book.
